Greeting and Seating

- 1. Please arrive promptly at 9:40, put on your nametag, and be sure that programs are available at the front of the church.
- 2. Greet parishioners and guests and hand out programs prior to the beginning of the service.
- Please be certain that everyone who arrives signs in. If you do not recognize someone
 as a parishioner or regular attendee, please be certain that he/she notes email address
 or cell number. (Per the Diocese)
- 4. Depending on the weather determine whether to leave door open between church and narthex.

Communion Flow

- At this time, Reverend Lisa is inviting all to Communion and directing the congregation on Communion flow.
- Oblations are already on the Altar and Ushers do not "lead" communion flow.

Clean-up and Counting

 Following the 10:00am service the usher gathers all three offering plates (rear of church and either side of Altar steps. All offerings placed in an envelope in the office – please sign and date envelope, note 10:00 am service, and place on Lisa Sommer's keyboard.
 Please proceed to straighten kneelers, and remove trash and recycling. (Put bulletins for recycling in proper receptacle in sacristy.)
